## PRESIDENT'S REPORT 2021 - 2022

Cricket in West Gippsland this past season looked quite different to that of just three years ago. Our season was truncated to 14 weeks, only one day cricket was played and there existed no representative cricket. However, we did manage to create some firsts with Tooradin enjoying its first Premier grade pennant since 2013, a new digital media platform (Game Face) was promoting our matches as well as the activities of the Association and we were attempting to produce a cricket structure where first elevens mostly played one another in the top two grades.

Because of the work devoted to creating a Strategic Plan, the WGCA has attempted to take cricket into the twenties. We live in a region where the population has expanded rapidly and the demands for improved infrastructure also need to be met. Our challenge is to cater for changing demographics as well as ensuring our cricket participation matches that growth. Female cricket has been initiated in West Gippsland with our U14 competition. The challenge for clubs is to create a pathway for girls similar to that we have traditionally established for males. Naturally, matching expansion means providing more volunteers. Another challenge! People need to be asked to help. Research states that most will say yes if they are approached personally.

In 2021/22 our Junior numbers were maintained in U10'S, U12's, while there was a slight drop in U14's and older age groups. Certainly, the pandemic affected family commitment to sport locally. This creates a challenge for all clubs to ensure the number of teams are available. We also should ensure that the cricket we provide satisfies people's needs to participate. In this situation maybe cricket needs to be modified to suit clients in the 2020's.

Our Board of Management has worked hard during the past 12 months and additional mandated policies require extra administration. Covid Protocols, Child Safety, etc all demand additional labour. The whole Association is indebted to Nicky Simpson who organized our fixtures for the first time. Shona Lynch, whose attention to detail is amazing, capably led the Junior Management committee. Narelle Stow, our My Cricket manager, made herself available over and beyond what was required. Thanks also go to Aaron Straughair for his financial acumen keeping the accounts healthy. Mike McKenna headed up the umpires and did a great job. Thanks, Mike, for your valuable work on the Board of Management. Our numero uno, Shane Dalton, has been the lynch pin for the WGCA ensuring all communications flow smoothly between clubs and other stake holders. Thanks for all your efforts, Shane. I would also like to thank the Senior Cricket Committee – Jack Anning, Bradey Welsh, Ben Parrott and Jamie Smith for assistance provided throughout the season.

Our sponsors – Kookaburra, Bendigo Bank, Cardinia Park Hotel, Evolution Sports and Star News group have lent the WGCA valuable support. In addition the Game Face crew have been at the forefront of promoting our brand.

The WGCA has been owned by the clubs. It's your Association. While we all see our individual clubs as the most important priority it is how we work together which will determine the success of the Association. Hopefully we can promote our brand in the future to make the Association the equal of any locally.
